Programme Update

Since our last Bulletin was issued we have continued to make excellent progress with the works on site.



The concrete frame to the Art Building has commenced with the walls and columns from the lower ground to ground floor constructed and the ground floor slab support deck and reinforcement installed in preparation for a concrete pour this Saturday 14th February.

The substructure works to the pool and fitness areas has also progressed well and we anticipate the majority of the earth removal from site being completed within the next 3 to 4 weeks which will result in a significant reduction in vehicle movements on the local roads.



Next 4 Weeks

Over the course of the next 4 weeks we will be progressing with the construction of the concrete frame to the Art Block.

The concrete structure to the Fitness block will also be progressing with the walls, columns and reinforced slab being constructed.

The sub structure works to the swimming pool area will also be nearing completion which will allow the swimming pool structure to commence.

We have worked 100,000 man hours on site since June 2014.

There have been no reportable accidents or incidents on site since we commenced our works.

There has been approximately 22,000 tonnes of earth removed from site.

Since works commenced on site there has been approximately 1500 vehicle movements to and from site.

In our last Considerate Constructor's audit we received an excellent score of 41 / 50.
