On behalf of the wider team, welcome to the February news letter and an update on your new leisure centre.

Where are we at?

We have established our offices and welfare facilities which provide the base to work from and are pleased to say that we are on programme.

As some of you historians will know the old leisure centre was constructed in two phases, the first part was built in 1930's which was used as the sports hall and the second part was added in the 1980's.

Interestingly the original swimming pool is still under the timber floor of the sports hall.

We are in the final stages of dismantling the 1980's building which has been carried out using a 21T excavator with specialist attachments on the end of the hydraulic arm.

The ground is being prepared for the new building with removing the top soil which has been saved for re-use later. The levels are also being shaped for the start of the new foundations.

What's next?

The next key activity that we will start is constructing the foundations to receive the structural steel frame at the end of April.

The other interesting milestone is the start of the new swimming pool that should begin start after Easter, weather permitting.
